1 What is student financial aid?

Sagamihara City provides financial aid for those that are attending the city's public elementary or junior high school. It is available for those who are in financial need and the money goes towards school materials, lunch money, etc.

- 2 Who is eligible?
 - People with low income
 - People who are receiving child support, etc.

3 How to apply

< If applying before entering elementary school > Application Period: Until the beginning of January before entering Submission: By mail or directly at the Division of School Administration The Board of Education will send you the application before entering, along with the physical exam notification.

* You will receive the money by the end of February when applied before entering.

< If applying when entering elementary school > Application Period: Until the beginning of April Submission: The elementary school s/he is attending Application will be given by the school.

< If applying at the time of grade promotion or in the middle of the school year > Application Period: Ongoing

Submission: By mail or directly at the Division of School Administration

Schools distribute the application in April every year. For any other months, you can receive the application from the school or the city hall's Division of School Administration, or download it from the website.

- 4 Note
 - You do not need to apply if you are receiving public assistance.
 - You may not be eligible depending on the evaluation.
 - If you have any questions, please ask the Division of School Administration or the person in charge of financial aid at your child's school.
