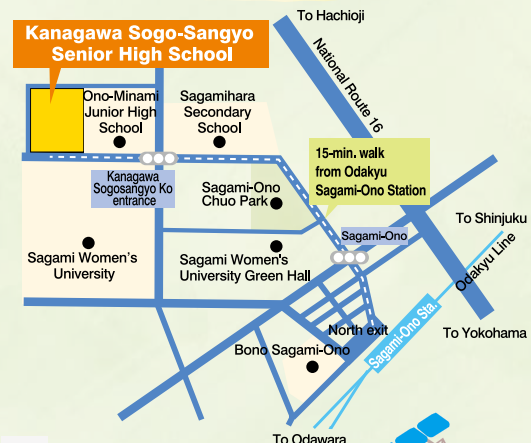
Note: Media coverage is possible only during Session 1.

Notes:

1. Before you can enroll, you must participate in one of the four orientation sessions.
2. If you cannot attend any of the sessions, please ask the Sagamihara City Board of Education what you should do.
3. You or someone that will accompany you on the day must register in advance to attend the orientation session (see back page).
4. If you need an interpreter on the day, please ask about it when you apply.

These orientation sessions are for individuals who wish to enroll in a night junior high school program. Residents of municipalities within Kanagawa Prefecture (excluding Yokohama City and Kawasaki City) can participate in these sessions.

Admission eligibility

Applicants must be of school age (i.e., born before April 1, 2009) and meet one of the following conditions:

1. Anyone who has reached school age without completing compulsory education.
2. Anyone who has graduated from junior high school without receiving sufficient education for various reasons.
3. Foreign nationals and others who have not received education equivalent to compulsory education in Japan.

What can you tell me about night junior high school?

- These are night classes of public junior high schools.
- There is no tuition, and all textbooks are free.
- Junior high school teachers specializing in each subject teach the classes.
- Classes are conducted from Monday to Friday, starting around 5 p.m. and ending around 9 p.m.
- If you graduate from night junior high school, you will receive a junior high school certificate.

5:25 to 6:10 p.m.	First period (45 min.)

7:15 to 8:00 p.m.	Third period (45 min.)
8:10 to 8:55 p.m.	Fourth period (45 min.)
8:55 to 9:00 p.m.	Last class gathering

1 Flow of the orientation session

2 Registration in advance

- (1) How to apply
 - Via phone or at the service window
Applications are accepted between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays.
 - Via fax or email **English available**
Be sure to include the following information:
1) Name of prospective student 2) Address 3) Phone number 4) Orientation session you wish to attend 5) Name of accompanying person (if applicable) 6) Whether you need an interpreter.
Note: In general, each prospective student may bring one other person along.
- (2) Application period
July 3 (Mon.) through October 11 (Wed.), 2023
Note: Applications are accepted up to two days before each orientation session.

[Process up to enrollment]

1. Participate in an orientation session
(July 14, September 5, October 4, or October 13)
2. Consult your local municipality
3. Complete an admission application form
4. Submit your completed application form to the Sagami-hara City Office (by the end of October)
Trial enrollment (optional)
(October 30, October 31, November 1, or November 2)
5. Interview at the school (during November)
6. Notification of interview results
→ Admission decided
