The Republic of Kakuda

Located in southern Miyagi Prefecture and overlooking the Zao Mountain Range to the west, Kakuda is one of the prefecture's leading rice-producing areas, blessed with fertile land fed by the Abukuma River. In addition to rice, soybeans, plums, vegetables, and fruit trees also thrive here. This is a city with an abundance of nature and ties to the Date clan of samurai. Several top-tier companies have established factories here for a city with a good balance between agriculture and industry. In the city's Daiyama Park is a full-scale model of the H-II rocket, the Space Tower observation deck, the Cosmo House space museum, and more, all of which serve as facilities for education and tourism.
